13. **Facilities of Training Institute** : **a) Location:** Bangabandhu PATC is located at kotalipara Upazila of Gopalganj District on 10.14 acres of land with 30 multi storied buildings and total campus is well protected with high boundary wall. It is 18 Km away from Gopalganj town beside Gopalganj-Paisarhat-Barisal regional high ways. It is 222 km away from Dhaka and well connected with direct bus services.
- b) Class Rooms:** There are 7 class rooms/training venues (including 1 A/C) with around 250 seat capacity. Adequate lighting facilities are provided with electrification and fuel generator as alternative systems. There is an integrated pond, nursery pond and mini carp hatchery, horticultural nursery in the campus for hands-on training.
- C) Accommodation and dining:** Banghabandhu PATC is a residential training Institute with 142 accommodation (General hostel-100, Officers-30, VIP Guest house-12 with 3 A/C). There are two separate cafeteria for male and female with 100 seats. Seat rents are 50/-, 100/- & 250/- (VIP)/day and Venue rents are 500/-, 1000/- & 1100/- (AC)/day respectively.

14. **Training Activities** : The following IGA and Skill Development Training Programmes are Conducted at Bangabandhu PATC. About 22,000 nos, of Training/Participants are attended in different Training/Workshop/Scminars Since its inception in 2001.
